The processing and preservation of cassava and sweet potato were very much appreciated in Middlebush. Families survived on preserved foods during food shortage following the devastating Cyclone Pam in 2015.



The project supported rice production in Middlebush for the first time. During Cyclone Pam in March 2015 when all gardens were destroyed, only rice survived. This generated much interest and more farmers took on the crop. In January 2016, they milled their first rice from a maro-mill supplied by the project.
